

**RESOLUTION
R127-08/09**

WHEREAS, as provided for in Section 11-43-44, Code of Alabama 1975, the members of the City Council, Mayor and President of the City Council, on this day, being Monday, November 3, 2008, did assemble and organize the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-43-56 of the Code of Alabama of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to dispose of personal property; and

WHEREAS, all former elected officials were given a blackberry and/or a cell phone that was purchased by the City of Selma for official use during the previous administration; and


WHEREAS, some of the former elected officials desire to purchase their cell phones and numbers from the City of Selma; and

WHEREAS, it is the City Council's desire to allow the same and declare that the personal property herein stated and owned by the City is not needed and shall be sold to the former elected officials at a depreciated value of its cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the personal property hereinabove described and owned by the City of Selma is not needed for municipal purposes and shall be disposed of by allowing the former elected officials to purchase the same at a depreciated value of the cost.
2. It is further resolved, declared and established by the City Council that the former Mayor shall be allowed to purchase his blackberry at a depreciated value of \$50.00 and the former city council members shall be allowed to purchase their cell phones at a depreciated value of \$10.


