

RESOLUTION

To Award Contract for the Emergency Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project

WHEREAS, the City of Selma accepted bids during the month of August 2011 for the Emergency Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on August 26, 2011 and the lowest responsible bidder was Tri-County Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$112,655.60; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2011, the City Council approved a budget for the project in the amount of \$103,400. During the design of this project, the engineer found another 214 foot section of pipe that was also in a deteriorated condition. The cost for the additional work is \$9,255.60.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

The City of Selma is hereby ordered to forward a signed copy of said resolution to Tri-County Construction, Inc. notifying the same of the City of Selma's acceptance and approval of the bid and is hereby awarded the contract for the Emergency Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project in the amount of \$112,655.60.


George Patrick Evans, in his official capacity as Mayor, is hereby directed to proceed with the execution of the contract awarded to Tri-County Construction, Inc.


